



Frequently Asked Questions

What is Night to Shine? It's an unforgettable prom night experience, centered on God's love for people with special needs, ages 14 and up.

Who is sponsoring the event? The Tim Tebow Foundation sponsors this great event worldwide. Valley Church has been selected to host Night to Shine for a second year. Many businesses within the community donate resources to help make this event a success.

When is the event? Friday, February 10, 2017. Officially the prom is from 5-9 pm. Most guests will want to participate in the various pre-prom activities, which begin at 3 pm.

Where is the prom? All guests will check in and be picked up at Valley Church. The dinner and prom will be held at Valley Community Center, across the street. Guests will enjoy a limo ride between buildings.

Who can attend? Anyone that is 14 years or older with a special need (however mild or severe) is welcome to attend!

What should I wear? This event is a formal prom, so our guests are asked to wear modest dresses or dress pants & ties. Suit coats/tuxedos are encouraged but not required. Please, no jeans.

What if I don't have anything fancy to wear?

Gentlemen: You can rent a full tux and shoes from Milroy's Tuxedos for only \$39.99+tax. They are located at 3839 Merle Hay Rd in Des Moines. Tell them it's for NTS.

What is Pre-Prom? This is a time for our guests to get pampered with photos, hair, make-up, nails, even shoe shines! There will also be snacks and karaoke.

Will there be food? Absolutely! There will be light snacks at pre-prom and a dinner of chicken strips, macaroni & cheese, green beans, applesauce or fruit cup, and a variety of desserts at prom itself. Let us know of any dietary needs.

Do I need a caregiver present? If a guest has a medical need that requires a trained staff member, we ask that the caregiver stay with them.

Do I need a date? Each guest will be provided a buddy for the evening. However, guests are welcome to bring their own date if they choose! Simply include their information on the registration form or let your welcome team member know.

Are there handicapped accommodations? The entire event is located on ground level. We will have Joy Ride available in lieu of a limo ride. Bathrooms are also handicapped accessible. If there is a specific need, please do not hesitate to ask us.

Will there be a place for family or caregivers to stay? We will have a Hospitality Room at the church for any family members/caretakers to utilize. This room will have live feed of the Prom and dinner will be included.

How much does it cost? There is no cost to our guests!
